- Hazards will be identified, and the risk of harm minimised, so far as is reasonably practicable, through a process of assessment, control, instruction, training, and supervision. - The Langstone Construction Group supports the concept of consultation with its staff on Health & Safety matters and has established a Group Safety Committee and a Health & Safety Committee, under the umbrella of a Group Health & Safety Steering Group, to provide a mechanism for such consultation with all those employed by the company.
